
### DEFINITION OF SO-CALLED CRITICAL STUDY PROGRAMMES AT THE FACULTY OF ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES OF THE CZECH UNIVERSITY OF LIFE SCIENCES IN PRAGUE

#### 1. Home

Dean's Instruction No. 3/2023 is issued as a methodological instruction of the Dean of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences to Dean's Regulation No. 11/2023, resp. 13/2023 Conditions of admission to bachelor's and master's degree programmes taught in Czech and English language. The Dean's Instruction defines the so-called critical study programmes in accordance with the European Union regulations that identify so-called critical study programmes in terms of possible violation of sanction measures of the European Union authorities against selected countries, namely Council Regulation (EU) No. 833/2014, No. 692/2014, 2022/263, Council Regulation (EC) No. 765/2006, which prohibit "direct or indirect provision of technical assistance" to Russia and Belarus.

#### 2. Definition of critical study programmes

At the Faculty of the Environmental Sciences, I classify all taught study programmes as critical study programmes. The main reason for this is the fact that the curricula include compulsory courses, the content of which necessarily includes activities involving work with information and data that may have sensitive content in relation to the protection of the interests of the Czech Republic and the possible misuse of which may have serious consequences in terms of protecting the security of the Czech Republic. This information is primarily sensitive geo-information data on the territory of the Czech Republic, which the student inevitably works with during the study of these courses included in the study plan of the study programmes of the FZP (especially the following subjects: Geographic Information Systems, GIS I and GIS II).
