Duccio Rocchini is a Professor in the University of Trento, Italy. He received his Ph.D. degree from the University of Siena, Italy, and, after a Post-Doc period in the same university, he moved to Markus Neteler's group in Fondazione Edmund Mach. His main research interests are related to species distribution modelling, spatial and computational ecology and ecological remote sensing. He is currently participating in H2020 projects ECOPOTENTIAL (as associate partner) and TRUSTEE as partner and member of the Supervisory Board, and the EU Life FutureForCoppices as Workpackage coordinator. He is author of more than 130 ISI papers (with an H-index of 29) and Associate Editor of Journal of Vegetation Science, Applied Vegetation Science, PLoS ONE, Ecological Informatics.
